Attributes of participating in Karate

The Five Maxims of Shorin-Ryu Karate:

- **CHARACTER:** Being morally and spiritually balanced.
- **SINCERITY:** Being dedicated to the art and being honest with others and yourself.
- **EFFORT:** Accepting the challenges presented in your study of the art. Be willing to work for what you earn.
- **ETIQUETTE:** Respect for instructors and all higher or lower ranks than yourself. Bow before entering and leaving any dojo.
- **SELF CONTROL:** Being able to control yourself in any situation without resorting to Karate.

Important emphasis on:

- Goal Setting
- Sense of accomplishment
- Working as an individual but in a community of individuals striving to better themselves.
- Anti-Bullying – Learning to deal and prevent, recognize the signs of bullying and most importantly not being a bully.
- Anti-Gang – Steering clear of groups or individuals that wish to pull you into this type of behavior.

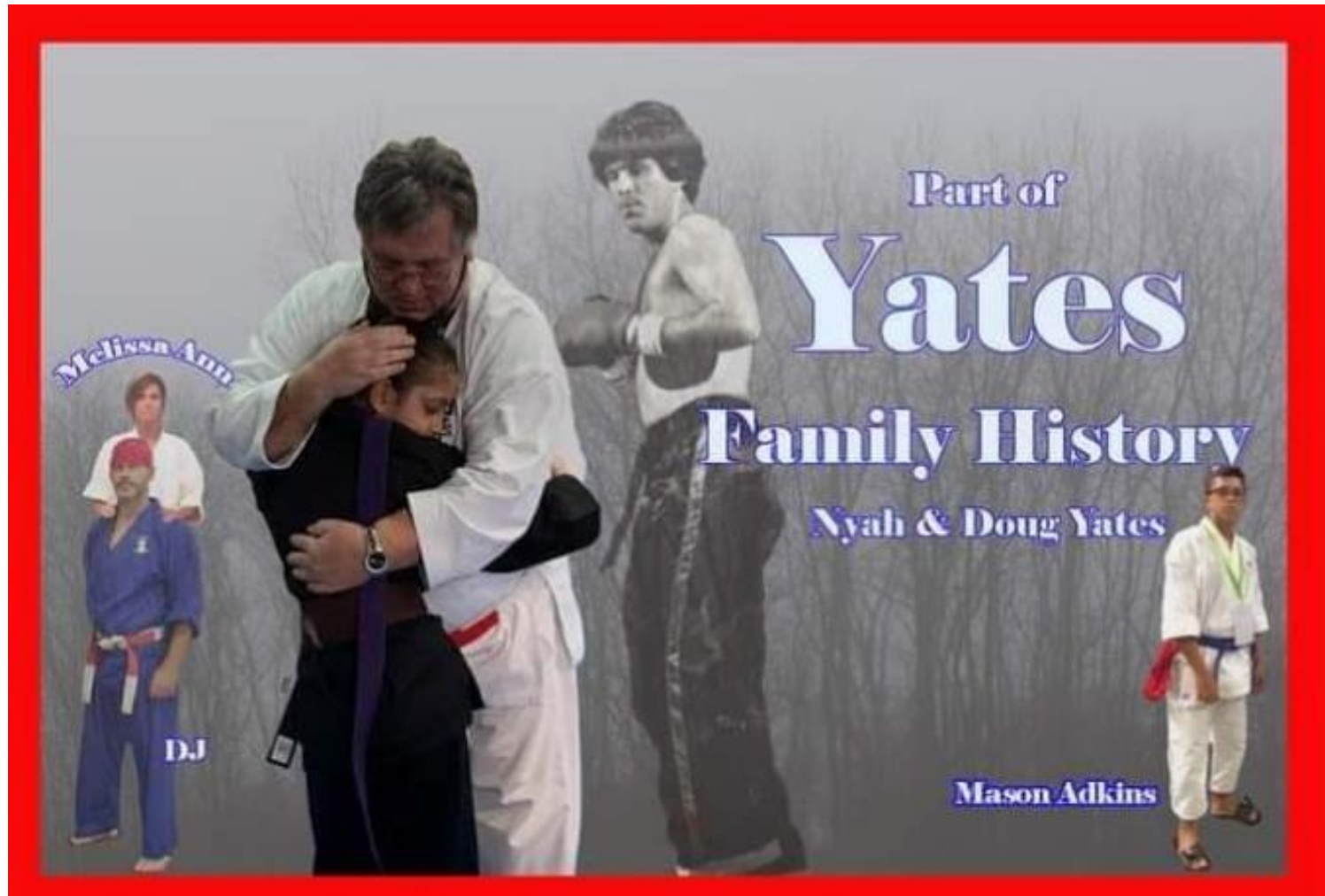

The Doug Yates Karate Foundation Inc. began February 28, 2023. The purpose is to provide support for individuals wishing to enroll, participate in Martial Art training and / or competition in or around Xenia and the greater Dayton area.

What Does the Foundation Do?

How the DYK Foundation helps support the Martial Arts Community: 3 Pillars (in order of importance and funding – i.e., Pillar 1 below gets fully funded before any funds are available for Pillar 2, and the same for Pillar 3):

- 1) Financial Support for Kids in Martial Arts
 - a. Help pay for uniforms/belts/accessories
 - b. Help pay for classes
 - c. Help pay for entry fees for tournaments
 - d. Capped at 50%
 - e. Criteria based on:
 - i. Order Requests are received (either by paper or electronic)
 - ii. Unless a reason exists for due diligence, requests for financial support will be taken at face value and the financial need is assumed.
- 2) Financial Support for Martial Arts Tournaments
 - a. Help pay for venues
 - b. Help pay for trophies
 - c. Capped at 50%?
 - d. Criteria based on:
 - i. Order Requests are received (either by paper or electronic)
 - ii. Unless a reason exists for due diligence, requests for financial support will be taken at face value and the financial need is assumed.
- 3) Scholarships for Kids in Martial Arts who are going to College or Trade School.
 - a. Criteria based on:
 - i. Applications Received in a certain timeframe (either by paper or electronic)
 - ii. Years in Martial Arts/Belt Rank, information about student and Martial art experience.
 - iii. Planning on attending college or trade school within the next 2 years
 - b. All funds available for this Pillar will be awarded based on the applicants who meet the criteria above.
